Multiple-Entry Visas for Chinese Temporary Visitors

Chinese applicants going to Japan for business, visiting relatives/acquaintances, and tourism, etc. without being engaged in remunerated activities for 90 days or less multiple times.

- -Chinese nationals residing in our jurisdiction may apply for a multiple-entry short-term visa if they have <u>sufficient income/assets</u>. Spouses, children, and parents of those with sufficient income/assets may also apply (In this case, they must apply at the same time as the main applicant or the main applicant must already have a multiple-entry visa.).
- -Depending on the details of the application, a multiple-entry visa is issued (1) for stays of up to 90 days and a validity period of 5 years or (2) for stays of up to 30 days and a validity period of 3 years. As a result of review, a visa may be denied or a single- or double-entry visa may be issued.
- -The applicant must have residence status in the US for <u>a minimum of 3 years</u> from the time of the application in order to be considered for a multiple-entry visa.

Applicants should submit the following documents. Additional documents may be requested during the course of review.
