


DON'T BE A VICTIM!

- WHEN IN A RESTAURANT OR STORE, DON'T LEAVE YOUR HANDBAG OVER THE BACK OF THE CHAIR, OR IN A SHOPPING CART UNATTENDED
- CARRY YOUR PURSE CLOSE TO YOUR BODY
- CARRY YOUR WALLET IN THE BREAST POCKET OF YOUR JACKET OR IN YOUR FRONT PANTS POCKET. NEVER IN THE REAR PANTS POCKET
- BE WARY OF CON ARTISTS. SOME DIVERT YOUR ATTENTION WHILE ANOTHER PICKS YOUR POCKET
